Barb has been asked to present to City Commission for approval to install them in the public right-of-way and she will attend March 12 City Commission meeting.

News Story. The tree removal news release generated a geat story in the Salina Journal. Barb and Greg also did a guest appearance on Friendly Fire to discuss the tree removal and give an update on North Salina. There has been very little negative response to the tree removal and many positive comments.

North 9th Street Project. Everything seems to be going well. Twenty eight trees were removed. Plans are to provide ornamental trees to substitute for the trees removed.

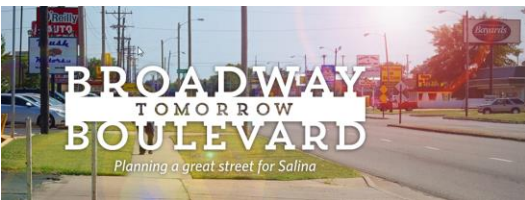
## New Business
