MINUTES FROM August 17, 2017 Meeting

Guest Presentation

Phyll Klima, Report on three Farmers Markets in Salina. One is located near Dairy Queen and a second Farmers Market location is Grand Avenue



Methodist church. This is second year of three-year grant. Phyll said they accept SNAP (EBT card) and she



explained Double Up Food Bucks program (Can receive double the food dollar up to \$25 for every dollar of SNAP) and encouraged North Salina to help get the



word out. The Grand Avenue location is one of highest in Salina, but could do better. Her Facebook page is Farm-to Fork and they are working with the Kitchen-for-Hire. The next Grand Avenue Farmers market is Tuesday, September 26 from 4-7 pm. IN winter months the Farmers market may be moved to the new Salina Fieldhouse, according to Klima.

Secretary's Report

Greg Stephens distributed the minutes from the July meeting. Art Grover moved to approve. Johnna Vosseller seconded the motion. The motion was approved.

Treasurer's Report

Johnna Vosseller gave the treasurers report. We have \$2,822.25 cash on hand and \$60,441.51 in the grant account. Lead Sled raised \$300.00 and we received \$200.00 more for the BBQ Hog roast picnic. Program expenses included 84.28 for spraying at the Sheriff's Mounted Patrol Project. After a brief discussion, Jon Blanchard moved to approve. Charles Ross seconded. Motion carried.

Old Business

Barb Young reported the the PrairieLand Food distribution has discontinued. Two other distributions are available- Kings Foods, Derby (WWW.kingsfoods.org) and Bountiful Baskets at Webster Conference Center.

Mounted Patrol site is completed and everything finished except final accounting and a ribbon cutting open house to be scheduled possible October 7th at 1:30 after the Fall fix-up event. We still need to do a dedication for the sculpture at Chuck's Bar and Grill.

Barb Young reported that Steve Brown and Rose Base are helping organize a meeting with the 9th Street owners. They have identified the trees for removal and are workign on preliminary plans for the proejct.

New Business

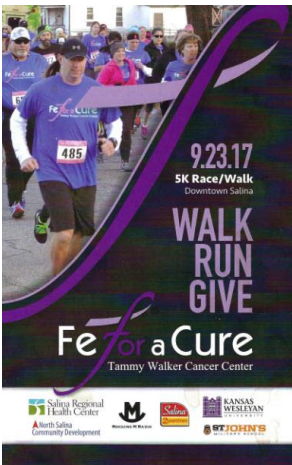
Greg Stephens reported that the presentation date for the North Salina Civic Engagement report to the City Commission during their regular Study Session is set for the September 11th.
