## MINUTES FROM November 19, 2017 Meeting

### Secretary's Report

Greg Stephens distributed the minutes from the July meeting. Gary Hobbie moved to approve with addition of Melissa Hodges present. Art Grover seconded the motion. Motion carried.

### Treasurer's Report

Johnna Vosseller gave the treasurers report. Nothing has changed from last month. We have \$4, 586.79 cash on hand and \$60,441.51 in the grant account. After a brief discussion, Jon Blanchard moved to approve. Art Grover seconded. Motion carried.



### **Old Business**

There was no report from the SDI meeting.

Barb Young gave an update on the Dane Hansen Grant project. The front porch project has started with porch repair at 1119 N 9<sup>th</sup> which is the "show property." More to be completed on it yet. Cool & Eitel volunteered all labor and the property owner paid for all costs. This was part of Fall Fixup which also had North Salina volunteers participating. The old tire collection netted \$622.00 worth of tires. First Covenant Church had kids volunteering to put our door hangers for the event. A request was made to get a tally of those who donated.

### **New Business**
